



POOL RULES & REGULATIONS

The Board of Directors, Pool Manager and Lifeguards are given full authority to enforce all the rules and City of Dallas Code Regulations.

The lifeguards have responsibility for the safety of members and guests within the pool grounds and volleyball court. Any disputes with lifeguard decisions must be taken up with the Lifeguard Manager or a Board Member. Lifeguards are authorized to stop activities deemed unsafe, prohibit use of unsafe, broken, or unauthorized pool equipment, close the pools due to safety, weather or sanitation reasons and remove persons not adhering to rules or affecting enjoyment of Club Members and guests.

- ***NO GLASS CONTAINERS OR BOTTLES ARE ALLOWED IN POOL OR VOLLEYBALL AREAS.***
- ***NO SMOKING, VAPING OR TOBACCO USE ALLOWED ON CLUB GROUNDS.***
- ***NO PETS ALLOWED WITHIN THE GATED AREAS.***
- ***NO ONE WHO IS ILL, HAS BEEN RECENTLY INJURED, HAS A SKIN INFECTION, OPEN WOUND OR OTHER COMMUNICABLE INFECTION MAY ENTER THE POOL.***
- ***ALCOHOL MAY NOT BE PROVIDED TO OR CONSUMED BY PERSONS UNDER 21 YEARS OLD. CONSUMPTIONS OF ALCOHOL BY MINORS WILL RESULT IN IMMEDIATE REMOVAL FROM CLUB GROUNDS.***
- Children who cannot swim must always be accompanied by an adult and must be within arm's reach while in the large pool.
- Children 6 - 9 years old must be accompanied by a person responsible for their care and the caretaker must be at least 16 years old.
- Children 10 and up may use the pool unaccompanied during regular hours when a lifeguard is on duty.
- The baby pool is not guarded. Children using the baby pool must be supervised by an adult or caretaker 16 years or older. Lifeguards may still enforce the safe operation of the baby pool.
- Lap swim hours are reserved for adult members only (18 years and older).
- Children are not allowed in the pool unaccompanied unless a lifeguard is present and on duty or if the "No Lifeguard On Duty" sign is posted.
- When the "No Lifeguard On Duty" sign is posted, all children must be accompanied by an adult.
- Use of the diving board is prohibited when no lifeguard is on duty and during lap swim hours.
- One lane of the pool may be used for lap swimming during regular hours and shall be reserved for lap swimming when a member requests use for that purpose.
- The pool may be closed for short periods to allow breaks for the lifeguards. Children are not allowed in the pool during these times.
- Improper language or rude or unruly behavior is not allowed. Continuation of this type of behavior is grounds for removal from the pool and volleyball areas.
- All members must present ID or a membership card to the front gate attendant upon request. Members should sign in and make payment for any guest fees. Guest fees apply even if the guest does not intent to use the pools.
- Lost-and-Found items may be disposed of or donated after the 15th of each month.
- Members are required to pick up after themselves. Trash cans and recycling bins are provided.
- The Board of Directors may modify or amend rules as necessary for the safe enjoyment of The Club.
